


Image description: A large aerial graphic of a map of downtown Toronto illustrating with a red drop where 401 Richmond Street West is located.

Information and images of the Space

There are two entrances to the 401 Richmond building.

Entrance #1



This is one entrance to building which is located close to the corner of Richmond Street West and Spadina Avenue. On the left, there is a set of stairs leading to the front door and to the right is a rough wooden and uneven ramp leading to a second door with a push button to automatically open the door. This is an image of the ramp at the entrance closest to Spadina, it has a brick floor and a metal railing. Due to the ramp being uneven and unmaintained, we recommend using the second entrance to the building detailed below.



Image description: This is an image of the glass door that is to the left at the top of the ramp, it has a push button and leads into the building by the coffee shop. There is a sign for the coffee shop inside the glass door that reads “Roastery”.

Entrance #2

The second entrance is located on Richmond Street, further east of the first entrance close to Peter Street.

When entering entrance #2, you will be on the basement level of the building. To get to the elevator to get to the first floor where Tangled is located, you will pass the coffee shop at the end of the ramp and travel down a long hallway until you see a green elevator door to your left. To the left of the elevator are signs that read what keeps a street active.

Take the elevator to the main floor. When leaving the elevator, turn right, walk down the hallway and turn right again down another hallway. At the end of this hallway, turn right again and the Tangled Art Gallery is located in this hallway on your left.
